Prequalification of Prospective Bidders

The University has entered into a Design Build contract with Rudolph and Sletten, Inc. for this project. Rudolph and Sletten, Inc. (LICENSE #198069) is conducting the prequalification process for the specialty trades for this project. This prequalification is for Phase 3 Construction. The Bidders, after selection, will assume the role of a specialty trade subcontractor. The University and Rudolph and Sletten, Inc. have determined that prospective bidders for specialty trades on this project must be prequalified to be eligible to participate in a competitive bid for this project. Bidders will be required to have the California contractor’s license(s), as indicated under the Bid Packages (BPs) section for each bid package scope of work.

General Description of the Project

Build a new Precision Cancer Medicine Building (PCMB) at Mission Bay. The PCMB will be devoted to UCSF’s precision cancer program, including cancer specialty clinics, infusion center, radiation oncology therapy, pharmacy, lab, MRI, LINAC and other related programs. The building is proposed to be six (6) stories and approximately 170,000 GSF. The site is located at the corner of 3rd Street and 16th Street in San Francisco, CA. The building will be physically connected to the existing UCSF Ron Conway Family Gateway Medical Building (Gateway Medical Building) and will share a lobby. Currently, one existing linear accelerator in the Gateway Medical Building is located within the PCMB site. The PCMB’s utilities will be partly fed from the existing Energy Center, which is under OSHPD jurisdiction.

Written notice regarding prequalification determination will be released on or around May 2017.

Any person or entity not satisfied with the outcome of the prequalification must file a writ challenging the outcome within 10 calendar days from the date of the Rudolph and Sletten's written notice regarding prequalification determination. Any assertion that the outcome of the prequalification process was improper will not be a ground for a bid protest. However, Rudolph and Sletten, Inc. and the University reserves the right to accept late submissions and to request, receive, and evaluate supplemental information under prequalification after the indicated time and date at its sole determination.

The dates, times, and location set for receiving and opening bids will be set forth in the Announcement to Prequalified Bidders and Advertisement for Bids.

Prequalification Policies

Rudolph and Sletten, Inc. and the University reserves the right to reject any or all responses to the Prequalification Questionnaire and to waive non-material irregularities in any response received.

Every effort will be made to ensure that all persons have equal access to contracts and other business

opportunities with the University within the limits imposed by law or University policy. Each Bidder may be required to show evidence of its equal employment opportunity policy. The successful Bidders and its subcontractors will be required to follow the nondiscrimination requirements set forth in the Bidding Documents and to pay prevailing wage at the location of the work.

The work described in the contract is a public work subject to section 1771 of the California Labor Code.

No contractor or subcontractor, regardless of tier, may be listed on a Bid for, or engage in the performance of, any portion of this Project, unless registered with the Department of Industrial Relations pursuant to Labor Code section 1725.5 and 1771.1.

This Project is subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement by the Department of Industrial Relations.

The successful Prequalified Bidder shall pay all persons providing construction services and/or any labor on site, including any University location, no less than the UC Fair Wage (defined as, \$13 per hour as of 10/1/15, \$14 per hour as of 10/1/16, and \$15 per hour as of 10/1/17) and shall comply with all applicable federal, state and local working condition requirements

All information submitted for prequalification evaluation will be considered official information acquired in confidence, and the University will maintain its confidentiality to the extent permitted by law.
