## **DESCRIPTION OF WORK:**

General Description: This Project shall improve approximately 52,000 gsf of exterior plaza area at the UCLA Medical Plaza complex. The scope of work shall include upgrades to hardscape, landscape, lighting and signage in the central area between the 100, 200 and 300 buildings. All work is on the exterior of the buildings. The Project shall construct a total of (4) trellis structures: one at each of the main entrances of the three buildings and one at the connecting stair from the Medical Plaza to the Ronald Reagan UCLA Medical Center. These structures shall mark the building entrances, provide a prominent place to identify building names, and create shaded seating areas for visitors. The scope of work shall also: replace worn surface pavers with new waterproofing patching and concrete paving to match campus standards; update existing monument signs to improve wayfinding, recognize donors, and distinguish the outpatient facilities from the hospital and other campus buildings; replace existing plant material; provide seating adjacent to the new planting areas; and provide new irrigation systems and lighting.

The University has bid and awarded a CM at Risk Contract to Rudolph and Sletten, Inc. (LICENSE #198069) (hereafter "CM/Contractor"). CM/Contractor is responsible for bidding and awarding all subsequent subcontractor packages, including this package. The successful Subcontractor Bidder shall sign a Subcontract Agreement directly with CM/Contractor, and shall be bound by all the terms of the contract between University and CM/Contractor. Refer to Appendix D - R&S / University Prime Contract Documents which contains the contract between University and CM/Contractor, attached to the subcontract bidding documents and incorporated by this reference.

<u>Bid Package 01 – Demolition/Miscellaneous (this contract):</u> This Bid Package consists of providing selective demolition of site improvements including site hardscape, site concrete as well as miscellaneous concrete repair.

The estimated construction cost of this bid package is \$125,000
