WHHS is seeking application responses to a Notice inviting prequalified** prospective bidders for, but not limited to the Bid Packages listed herein, which WHHS reserves the right to modify. In addition, prequalified** prospective bidders will be required to possess valid and current California State Contractor's License Board Classification(s), at the bid due date and time, as designated.

DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT:

The overall project comprises of construction of a new three-story hospital building, with one ground floor partially above grade and two additional floors above grade, one basement floor to house a Seismic-Isolation foundation system, and a rooftop penthouse for mechanical electrical equipment. A service passage will connect the new building to the existing Underground Service Passage at the basement level. The new building has a footprint of approximately 61,000 square feet, a total of 224,800 gross square feet (excluding outdoor terraces and a roof garden).

WHHS will accept bids from applicants approved as meeting the prequalification criteria. WHHS intends to assign the awarded subcontracts to the CM/GC. Bid Packages, including Plans and Specifications will be issued (electronically only) to prequalified** prospective bidders on various dates.

WHHS encourages participation of Local Business Enterprises, Small Business Enterprises and local construction workforce. Prevailing wage is required as provided by law, and subcontracts may be subject to a project labor agreement (PLA). Certain project insurance will be provided through an Owner Controlled Insurance Program (OCIP).

100% Payment and Performance Bonds are required for all subcontract amounts over \$50,000. Workers' Compensation Waiver of Subrogation and Bid Bonds will be required by all Subcontractors.

WHHS specifically reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to reject any or all applicant responses or bids, to re-issue RFQ's, or to waive inconsequential defects in responses or bids not involving time, price or quality of the work. WHHS may reject any and all responses or bids and waive any minor irregularities in the responses or bids.
