

What is the UCIP?

Overview

A single, consolidated insurance program purchased by the University of California to cover all tiers of subcontractors on a specific project site with the exception of certain scopes of work

Benefits

- Everyone insured under one program
- Limits dedicated to the project
- Higher limits and broader coverage
- Uniform and consistent coverage for project duration
- One insurance program responds to all claims

Highlights

- General Liability & Workers' Compensation Zurich Insurance
- \$100mil Excess Liability Various insurance carriers
- Covers UC projects in excess of \$25mil contract value

Bid Instructions

- All subcontractors must have an EMR below 1.15 (5 year average)
- Form 1b Declaration of Minimum Occupational Safety & Health Qualifications
- All subcontractors must EXCLUDE insurance costs from bids
- These costs will be documented through the insurance cost worksheet and verification step of UCIP Enrollment
- UCIP language must be carried through to all tiers of subcontractors on the project site (unless they will be performing an excluded scope of work)





Excluded Scopes of Work

- Any hazardous material abatement, removal, and remediation
- Heavy or structural demolition
- Architects, engineers, or any other professional / consulting scope of work
- Off-site fabrication or manufacturing only to be delivered to the project site
- Any trucking, hauling, or moving of materials, tools, etc. where a subcontractor would be dropping off items at a site then leaving
- Any subcontractor specifically deemed excluded by the University of the California, at its own discretion
