Subject to conditions prescribed by UCSD, R&S is requesting prospective bidder prequalification applications for the trade package listed below. In addition, prequalified prospective bidders will be required to possess valid and current California State Contractor's License Board Classification(s), at the bid due date and time, as designated below:

DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT: The Outpatient Pavilion Project comprises approximately 150,000 gsf OSHPD-3 compliant outpatient and clinical facilities to accommodate hospital-licensed services and programs in support of the Jacobs Medical Center. This facility will serve as a platform to improve outpatient care delivery at UC San Diego by housing disease-specific centers consolidating all outpatient, ancillary, professional and support services needed to treat specified conditions.

The work described in the contract is a public work subject to section 1771 of the California Labor Code.

ALL CONTRACTORS AND SUBCONTRACTORS MUST BE REGISTERED WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS (DIR) AT BID TIME.
