## **DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT:**

UC SAN DIEGO (UCSD) and Rudolph and Sletten, Inc. (R&S) (LICENSE #198069) are requesting bids from prequalified prospective bidders for the listed bid package.

The Outpatient Pavilion Project comprises approximately 150,000 gsf OSHPD-3 compliant outpatient and clinical facilities to accommodate hospital-licensed services and programs in support of the Jacobs Medical Center. This facility will serve as a platform to improve outpatient care delivery at UC San Diego by housing disease-specific centers consolidating all outpatient, ancillary, professional and support services needed to treat specified conditions.

The Project is being constructed by subcontractors each working under a separate contract or contracts with Rudolph and Sletten, Inc. This procurement is for subcontractors to perform the bid package of the project as listed.

Start of construction for this 20-month project commenced in November 2015.

The work described in the contract is a public work subject to section 1771 of the California Labor Code.
