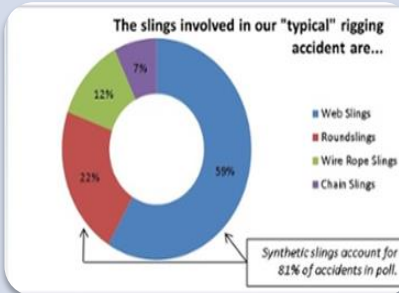

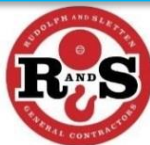


On Friday afternoon and Saturday Morning we had rigging malfunctions on 2 different projects. 1 of them resulting in an R&S worker being injured

All Jobsites : that are hoisting material, equipment or steel need to inspect rigging equipment.
 Review signals, or communication devices with your team are they effective and is the person qualified
 Review restricted areas barricades. Red or Yellow tape. Are they effective to keep people out of harms way ?

1. Rigging Malfunction: material slipped out of rigging and fell to the ground
2. Signal person miscommunication : Iron workers were getting ready to hang a 6X6X20 column when the base plate got caught on a another piece of steel when they lifted it the wire rigging broke and the piece of steel fell onto the deck.
