DESCRIPTION OF WORK

The SSU MasterCard Pavilion Phase B is the next phase in the construction of an outdoor amphitheater adjacent to the Green Music Center on campus at Sonoma State University located at 1801 East Cotati Avenue, Rohnert Park, California. The Main stage is a 10,000 SF structure with concrete walls, steel roof structure and tensile fabric roof system. The Stage Pavilion shall have a dedicated loading dock, storage, lighting, AV & Electrical infrastructure to support the outdoor performance venue for contemporary performances during the summer months.

BIDDING PROCESS

Bid Security in the amount of 10% of the Lump Sum Base Bid, excluding alternates, shall accompany each Bid. If a Bid Bond is submitted, the surety issuing the Bid Bond shall be, on the Bid Deadline, an admitted surety insurer (as defined in the California Code of Civil Procedure Section 995.120). Review the bid instructions for each trade for specific requirements. SSU and R&S requires the successful bidder to achieve three percent (3%) DVBE participation in contracting construction projects as established in the bidding documents, and this must occur prior to the bid opening. Bidder will be given an incentive for exceeding 3% participation of a DVBE. A 3% preference shall be applied to Contractors achieving 4 -6% participation. A 5% preference shall be applied to Contractors achieving 7-10% participation. DVBE status shall be verified prior to incentive being applied. A letter supporting DVBE participation must be submitted with the bid documents and include the DVBE company name, address, contact phone number, DVBE certification number, product or service to be supplied, and the total cost.
