Subject to the conditions prescribed by the SLAC National Accelerator Laboratory ("SLAC"), Menlo Park, California, which Stanford University manages and operates under Prime Contract No. DE-AC02-76-SF00515 with the U.S. Department of Energy ("DOE"), Rudolph and Sletten, Inc. (R&S) (LICENSE # 198069) is soliciting a request for qualifications (RFQ) from including, but not limited to, Lump Sum Pre-Qualified* Prospective Bidders certified*** as:

PHOTON SCIENCE LABORATORY BUILDING (PSLB) PROJECT AT SLAC

GENERAL SCOPE OF WORK

Project consists of the fit out of a building shell located at SLAC National Accelerator Laboratory in Menlo Park, CA 94025. The building shell is an approximately 100,000 total gross square foot (GSF) three-story concrete frame structure with construction currently underway. The project is targeting 55,000 to 100,000 GSF of fit-out; this construction effort is for the fit-out of the first/lower two floors.

The objective of the PSLB Project is to fit out the building shell to provide specialized laboratories, building core, elevators, building systems, and related supporting infrastructure to enable a range of simulation, theory and modeling, synthetic and characterization capabilities in support of study of ultrafast physical, chemical, and biological processes and materials synthesis. The fit out will provide laboratory and office spaces, provision of furniture, and all mechanical, electrical, plumbing, and fire protection equipment and utilities.

ESTIMATED VALUE

The total estimated Subcontract range including all Subcontract options is \$37M

PRE-QUALIFICATION OF SPECIALTY TRADE CONTRACTORS

R&S has determined that Prospective Bidders must be Pre-Qualified*. Pre-qualification will be determined by means of a written questionnaire and additional information which all potential Prospective Pre-Qualified Bidders must complete and submit for evaluation by R&S to establish their qualifications. R&S will establish a list of Pre-Qualified Prospective Bidders. A single firm will be selected for award of each BP described herein. R&S will determine whether a Prospective Bidder is Pre-Qualified.

Each Prospective Pre-Qualified Bidder must answer all of the questions and provide all requested information, where applicable. Any Prospective Pre-Qualified Bidder failing to do so may be deemed to be not responsive and not responsible with respect to this RFQ. All information submitted for pre-

PRE-QUALIFICATION FACTORS

The <u>minimum</u> requirements for all Prospective Bidders wishing to submit their pre-qualification documents are:

- A. Hold a current and valid BP specific Contractor License in the State of California as required.
- B. Have (during approximately the last three (3) years) completed at least one (1) project with a final contract value of more than the published BP specific value(s).
- C. Have average construction revenue of greater than three (3) times the published BP specific value(s) over the most recent three (3) fiscal years.
- D. Have single project bonding capacity greater than published BP specific value(s) as confirmed by a reputable Surety Company.
- E. Have asset to liability ratio for the 2015 (or 2014 if 2015 financial statements are not yet available for review) fiscal year is greater than or equal to one (1.00)
- F. Have a satisfactory safety record. SLAC desires that subcontractors have Experience Modification Rates (EMRs) as determined by the CA Workers Compensation Insurance Rating Bureau of 1.0 or less over the last three (3) complete years. Exceptions may be granted. Firms with an EMR of greater than 1.0 in one of the last three years should provide additional information regarding the circumstances that caused the higher EMR. A decision to grant an exception to this requirement is at the sole discretion of R&S.
- G. Have a corporate Injury and Illness Prevention Program in compliance with California OSHA Title 8, Section 3203 requirements.
- H. Prospective Bidders must submit <u>all</u> required information.

Note: Not all questions in the pre-qualification questionnaire are taken into consideration for pre-qualification; some questions are for informational purposes only.
